



Benin home solar system

Benin has unveiled a EUR45 million (29.51 billion CFA francs) solar energy program led by Axian Energy in partnership with Sika Capital, aimed at powering around 50,000 households and advancing the country's energy strategy. The Off-Grid Electricity Access Project (OGEAP) in Benin is a component of the Benin Power Compact, a \$391 million effort funded by the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) from 2016 to 2021. The OGEAP was allocated \$31 million to improve off-grid electrification with the Off-Grid Clean Energy. Benin's government has reaffirmed its intention to make renewable energy the main source of the country's power supply by 2030. Access to electricity in Benin remains both low and highly uneven: Around 42% of urban households are connected, with less than 13% in rural areas. With financial and technical support from a variety of sources, Benin has unveiled a EUR45 million (29.51 billion CFA francs) solar energy program led by Axian Energy in partnership with Sika Capital, aimed at powering around 50,000 households and advancing the country's energy strategy. The project will see the construction of four solar power plants in Bohicon. Infrastructure funded by the compact includes 18 substations and nearly 900 kilometers of new or upgraded high and medium-voltage power lines. The compact is also supporting off-grid electrification through mini-grid construction and the provision of solar home systems. .
