This is the case in most of Europe, Australia, the United Kingdom and most countries in Africa and Asia. Do I need a travel adapter for a Bhutan Charger? However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Bhutan outlet. Bhutan uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types C, D & G (see images).
