As of decade, the interconnected network power production comes from two national hydroelectric power plants Mugere and Rwegura, and some smaller power plants in addition to the two regional power stations of Ruzizi 1 and 2. How much energy does Burundi use?However, in Burundi hydropower which is the main source of clean energy is less represented, about 96.6 % of the total energy consumption is in the form of wood and charcoal burning while electricity is only 0.6 %, and 2,7 % and 0.1 % represent petroleum products and others, respectively .
