



Colombia's new energy storage policy

Does Colombia have a coal policy? From 2015 to 2020, domestic energy supply of coal decreased by 36% and the use of coal for electricity generation fell by 45%. Coal resources belong to the state and their exploitation is controlled by the MME. Colombia's energy and climate policy strategies do not include specific phase-out targets for coal production or consumption. Could Colombia benefit from a normative energy system? Colombia could benefit from the development of a normative energy system scenario that is consistent with the legislated goal of net zero emissions by 2050, set out in the Climate Action Law (Ley 2165). How does Colombia ensure security of electricity supply? The main mechanism to ensure security of electricity supply is Colombia's reliability charge, which has also seen increasing participation from renewable energy capacity since 2015. The scarcity pricing formula was reformed in 2016 and today reflects the cost of the oldest diesel generator. Why did Colombia adopt new security of gas supply rules in 2020? In 2020, the Colombian government adopted new security of gas supply rules. Resolution 40280 of 30 August updated the framework for the MME to regulate gas demand constraints and rationing of the supply of natural gas to satisfy essential demand of priority consumers, refineries, and industry. How does the IEA support Colombia's energy transition? The IEA supports Colombia's agenda for a just energy transition. Experience from the IEA's Global Commission on People-Centred Transitions provides useful learnings for the government of Colombia, helping to boost local economic benefits and the transition to clean energy and new job opportunities. What Reindustrialisation policy is pursuing in Colombia? Colombia is pursuing a reindustrialisation policy with the aim to shift from an extraction economy to a productive and sustainable knowledge economy.
