How much does electricity cost in Ivory Coast? Ivory Coast, September : The price of electricity is 0.122 U.S. Dollar per kWh for households and 0.207 U.S. Dollar for businesses which includes all components of the electricity bill such as the cost of power, distribution and taxes. By Cote d'Ivoire aims for renewables to represent 45% of the power mix and GHG emissions to decrease by 30% relative to a BAU scenario. Eranove, through CIE, CIPREL and Atinkou, dominates power generation with a share of 39%. Around 80% of natural gas is produced by Foxtrot, while CNR accounts for around 70% of crude oil output.
