



Energy Storage Power Station Subsidy Measures

Are government subsidies sufficient for energy storage? The government's incentive funds, including policy publicity and fiscal subsidies designed to encourage investment and industrial growth among energy storage operators, are insufficient compared to the national fiscal subsidies granted to the energy storage industry. Specifically, the subsidy coefficient $S = 1 - D$. What is the energy storage capacity subsidy? Additionally, the energy storage capacity subsidy is a one-time payment of 200 CNY/kW, while there are ongoing subsidies for charging and discharging (0.5 CNY/kWh) and for peak-valley arbitrage (0.7 CNY/kWh). Energy storage operators become proactive when their participation profit coefficient exceeds a critical threshold. How long is the energy storage subsidy period? The subsidy period lasts for 3 years following the completion of the energy storage project. Furthermore, depreciation and maintenance costs for the energy storage system are estimated to be 4 % of the initial system investment cost. The relevant data are summarized and presented in Supplementary Information Table D.1.1. What is the probability of a power system selecting incentive subsidies? The initial settings assume that the probability of the government selecting incentive subsidies (x) is 0.5, the probability of the energy storage operator choosing a support strategy (y) is 0.4, and the probability of the power system selecting an active transformation strategy (z) is 0.3.
