



Energy storage system construction subsidies implemented

On 15 July, the Federal Court of Justice (BGH) ruled (case no. EnVR 1/24) that network operators in network connection procedures under the Energy Industry Act (EnWG) may demand a construction cost subsidy (BKZ) for battery storage systems (BESS) based on the performance price model (BGH press release 15 July 2024). In autumn two draft regulations were published regarding state aid for large-scale electricity storage systems (BESS), one from the Modernisation Fund ("MF") 1 - and the second under the National Recovery and Resilience Plan ("RRP") 2. These two subsidy schemes, now under legislative review.
