How much battery storage will Greece have in 2025? By the end of 2024, Greece's third battery storage auction will offer 200 MW of standalone battery projects, bringing the total capacity from all three auctions to 900 MW, inching closer to the initial goal of 1,000 MW. The 1,000 MW battery storage target was set in 2023 as part of Greece's National Recovery and Resilience Plan. What is the future of battery storage in Greece? Overall, following last month's public consultation, the Greek ministry of the environment and energy presented a bolder and even more ambitious battery storage program, allowing for longer completion times but retaining the financial and competition guarantees in place. What is Greece's battery storage target? The 1,000 MW battery storage target was set in 2023 as part of Greece's National Recovery and Resilience Plan. This plan was initially introduced in response to the COVID-19 pandemic but shifted focus to support Greece's green energy transition. Will Greece install 900 MW of storage by 2025? According to the Greek National Energy and Climate Plan (NECP), the nation aims to install 4.3 GW of storage by 2025. Thus far, 900 MW has been allocated via the Greek Regulatory Authority for Energy, Waste, and Water (RAAEY) tenders.
