How much energy does a 400 watt solar panel produce? A 400-watt solar panel will produce anywhere from 1.20 to 1.80 kWh per day (at 4-6 peak sun hours locations). The biggest 700-watt solar panel will produce anywhere from 2.10 to 3.15 kWh per day (at 4-6 peak sun hours locations). Typically, a 250 watt solar panel running at its maximum efficiency for 7 hours a day can provide you with 1.75 kWh of output. Again, it will depend on the sunlight and the positioning of the panel. Based on our energy output estimates for a location with five sunlight hours, a 500-watt solar panel would produce approximately 2.5 kWh: $500 \text{ watts} \times 5 \text{ hours} = 2,500 \text{ watts}$ OR approximately 2.5 kWh per day. How can you increase solar panel efficiency? How many kWh can a 300 watt solar panel produce? You'd need approximately twenty-two 300-watt solar panels to produce 1,000 kWh per month. The equation is: $300 \text{ watts} \times 5 \text{ hours} = 1.5 \text{ kWh per day}$. $1.5 \text{ kWh} \times 22 \text{ solar panels} = 33 \text{ kwh per day}$. $33 \text{ kWh} \times 30 \text{ days} = 990 \text{ kWh per month}$. How many Watts Does a solar panel produce? The optimal solar panels produce 250 to 400 watts of electricity.
