



Hungary commercial energy storage system

Is Hungary's largest battery energy storage system a met investment? Hungary's largest operating standalone battery energy storage system (BESS) has been inaugurated today. It is the latest example in a series of MET investments in BESS projects across Europe. How much does Hungarian government spend on energy storage projects? The Hungarian government has allocated HUF 62 billion (EUR 158 million) for energy storage projects with an overall 440 MW in operating power. Hungarian authorities launched the tender for grid-scale batteries on January 15 and received offers until February 5. The winning bidders were selected a few days ago. What is Hungary's energy storage goal? The ministry said that Hungary has set its energy storage goal at 1 GW in the updated National Energy and Climate Plan. What percentage of Hungary's consumption is in storage facilities? FM Szijjártó recently stated that 28.5 percent of Hungary's total annual consumption is in the country's storage facilities. This does not look good considering that roughly two-thirds of Hungary's consumption, 6 bcm, occurs in the period between November and March. Holoda, however, interprets the situation differently. How much solar power does Hungary have? State secretary for energy transition of the Energy Ministry Viktor Horvath noted that Hungary had built more than 8,000MW of solar capacity in the past 5-6 years and one-quarter of the electricity generated in the country came from renewable sources last year.
