Israel has awarded 1.5 GW of energy storage contracts across 11 projects, with a total investment of \$840M. The projects, set to be operational by , will enhance renewable energy integration. The Israeli Electricity Authority (IEA) has awarded contracts for 1.5 GW of high-voltage battery storage across 11 projects in a recent tender. The awarded facilities will be developed in three key regions, helping integrate renewable energy into Israel's power grid. The tender attracted 11 bidders. Enlight has secured a grid connection for 300 MW via two projects in Israel, which will add between 1,300 to 1,900 MWh of energy storage to the grid.
