The Danish company has previously stated its intent to invest EUR1.6 billion (\$1.8 billion) into wind and solar generation in the Baltic state. As the country moves away from reliance on Russian energy and Lithuania's Ministries of Energy and Environment have approved an additional EUR37 million to expand capital expenditure support for energy storage projects. This funding supplements an existing EUR102 million fund managed by the Environmental Project Management Agency (EPMA) during its first call for projects on the continental European electricity grid. In case of accidents, batteries will provide instantaneous electricity and serve service in less than one second. In the future, batteries will help start supplying power within 15 minutes. Once synchronised with the CEN system, the energy storage facilities will be able to provide power within 15 minutes.
