Should Malaysia export solar panels? The minister emphasised that besides solar panel exports, Malaysia is also strong in the E&E sector and should consider expanding into other consumer products. Previously, the US announced a tariff hike on solar equipment exported from Southeast Asia to protect its domestic industry. Did Malaysia import solar panels from China? "The solar industry is a major part of the energy sector, which contributes nearly 20 per cent to Malaysia's gross domestic product (GDP). "As such, it is highly advisable for the country to diversify its solar panel export markets beyond the US due to the ongoing high tariffs," he told Bernama recently. Are solar panels made in Malaysia? Per an interviewee, Malaysia's only real local solar manufacturing is mounting structure production. So, Chinese firms largely import their own components, and only manufacture and assemble solar panels in Malaysia. However, even these panels manufactured and assembled in Malaysia are not used by local firms.
