The 24MW Rangitaiki solar farm in the Bay of Plenty first began New data from the Electricity Authority Te Mana Hiko shows energy from solar farms have been hitting new records this summer, with a historic peak of 128MW reached on 2pm, Thursday 6 March. From 2-8 March, (Figure 1) there was 69MW of mean daytime solar generation and total weekly generation. In October, Electricity Authority data showed 43,641 solar systems installed across New Zealand, adding up to 240 MW.
