



Niger solar power generation manufacturers

Who financed a solar power plant in Niger? The European Union, the French Development Bank and the government of Niger co-financed the installation. A French consortium made up of Akuo and Sagecom has finished building a 30 MW solar power plant in Gorou Banda, Niger. The Niger government had initially planned the project to have a capacity of 50 MW. Where is solar energy used in Niger? Solar energy is well-suited for use in Niamey and Zinder, located at lower latitudes, as they show less variability in solar radiation throughout the year. Niger has a long history of solar energy use, which began in the mid-1960s with the establishment of the Centre National d'Energie Solaire (National Solar Energy Centre; CNES). Are there any off-grid solar energy systems in Niger? Yes, there is considerable experience of off-grid solar energy systems in Niger. These include off-grid PV electrification, water pumping, and solar water heating systems. The main decentralised renewable energy system promoted in Niger for rural electricity is solar PV. What is the proposed price of the solar plant in Niger? The government of Niger is negotiating a PPA for a 20 MW solar plant with a French company. However, this project is facing opposition due to the proposed price of USD 0.165/kWh, which is significantly higher than imports from Nigeria but lower than the utility domestic generation costs. How has solar technology been promoted in Niger? Solar PV and other solar energy technologies have been promoted in Niger through various outlets, including the national school television programme. Installation of solar technology has continued, particularly in PV pumping areas and through education and health infrastructure electrification. Are there wind power generators in Niger? There are no grid-connected wind power generators in Niger. While there are windy areas suitable for wind power generation in the northern part of the country, these tend to be sparsely populated.
