How much money does Poland spend on battery energy storage? Poland has finalized a comprehensive subsidy program aimed at accelerating the deployment of battery energy storage systems (BESS), with a total budget of PLN 4 billion (approximately EUR1 billion). How big is Poland's energy storage capacity? Currently, Poland has a total installed storage capacity of 1.4 GW, 85% of which comes from pumped hydro storage facilities. Looking ahead, 2.1 GW of BESS capacity is slated to come online by .
