Does Poland have a baseload power system? P. Kubiczek, Baseload power. The structure of the Polish wholesale electricity market follows the typical West European model in that energy can be traded on a bilateral basis using "over the counter" standard contracts, via the PolPX power exchange, and also in the balancing market operated by the Polish TSO. Why should Polish energy policymakers be able to decarbonise? Doing so will ensure that the energy system can decarbonise quickly while also remaining economically competitive to support industry. Poland's transmission system operator, PSE, is the owner and operator of the national transmission grid. PSE is in turn wholly owned by the State Treasury.
