What is the energy storage system in the Seychelles? The project includes an energy storage system with a capacity of 5MW and 3.3 megawatt-hours (MWh), allowing for the safe and stable supply of electricity from the PV power plant to the main island of Mahé; and further increasing the resilience of the national grid of the Seychelles.
