Will South Korea bid for offshore wind projects in 2023? South Korea's Energy Agency has announced a competitive bidding for offshore wind projects with a capacity of 1.25 GW and 1 GW solar projects in the first half of 2023. The offshore wind tender for the first half of this year will focus on fixed-bottom projects. When will offshore wind tenders start in South Korea? According to South Korea's Ministry of Trade, Industry and Energy (MOTIE), the competitive bidding for offshore wind will be taking place twice a year. The floating offshore wind and onshore wind tenders are planned to be launched in the second half of this year, and the capacity offered will depend on demand and the remaining volume. What is the deadline for a wind project in South Korea? Deadline is on 22 November 2022. South Korea has launched tenders for nearly two gigawatts (GW) of wind projects. Broken down, 1 GW has been set aside for fixed bottom offshore, 500 megawatts (MW) for floating offshore, and 300 MW for onshore wind. Deadline for a project depends on its division and capacity. How many MW of offshore wind will South Korea offer? Out of the total 1.25 GW capacity, 500 MW will be offered through the public-led bidding market, with the remaining 750 MW designated for the general bidding market. According to South Korea's Ministry of Trade, Industry and Energy (MOTIE), the competitive bidding for offshore wind will be taking place twice a year. How will South Korea accelerate offshore wind deployment? Earlier this year, South Korea passed a Special Act through which it aims to accelerate offshore wind deployment by streamlining planning, approvals and permitting, starting with designation of planned offshore wind zones.
