It is interesting to note that the intensity of solar irradiation in lowland areas is high compared to mountainous regions. What is solar energy used for? Solar energy is used worldwide and is increasingly popular for generating electricity or heating and desalinating water. Solar power is generated in two main ways: Photovoltaics (PV), also called solar cells, are electronic devices that convert sunlight directly into electricity. What is concentrated solar power (CSP)? Concentrated solar power (CSP), uses mirrors to concentrate solar rays. These rays heat fluid, which is run through a heat exchanger to create steam to drive a turbine and generate electricity.
