Syria has not explored for oil and natural gas in its EEZ, though legal preparations to commence exploration were under way prior to the war. Like its neighbors in the Eastern Mediterranean, Syria is likely to discover oil and gas resources in its EEZ. Will Syria increase its oil and natural gas volumes? Syria has significant potential to increase its oil and natural gas volumes. Syria can also serve as a transit state for natural gas from Israel and other producers in the Eastern Mediterranean to Turkey and onward to Europe.
