



Does Tajikistan have a power system?The existing electrical transmission and distribution systems of Tajikistan, designed in the 1970s during the Soviet era, are also being upgraded and expanded, allowing transmission of power from Tajikistan to surrounding countries. Can Tajikistan become a net energy exporter?The Government of Tajikistan aims to transform itself from a net energy importer to a net energy exporter, on the strength of its potential for hydropower and solar power production. According to the World Bank, Tajikistan's power production is 92 percent hydropower, six percent hydrocarbon, and two percent from other sources. How will electricity exports benefit Tajikistan?Profits from electricity exports will contribute to the financial recovery of the Tajik national power utility company, allowing Tajikistan's electrical utilities to reconstruct existing power infrastructure and attract financing for construction of new generation and transmission infrastructure. Is biomass a source of electricity in Tajikistan?Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. Nuclear power - alongside renewables - is a low-carbon source of electricity. What is Tajikistan's hydropower potential?Tajikistan's hydropower potential is estimated at 527 billion kWh per year, which exceeds the existing electricity consumption of the countries of Central Asia by 300%. The country's largest project is the Roghun Dam Hydropower Plant project, which when completed is estimated to produce Megawatts of energy.
