



Togo Commercial Energy Storage Project

Togo has begun construction on a 25 MW solar plant with 36 MWh of battery storage in the country's north. China's TBEA International Engineering is leading the project, which is scheduled for completion within 13 months. An installation ceremony for the project took place last week.

Togo is taking a significant leap forward in its energy transition by launching a 55 MW pilot project for battery storage. This ambitious initiative, backed by a EUR25 million loan from the French Development Agency (AFD) and the Global Energy Alliance for People and Planet (GEAPP), is set to
