



UK energy storage project approval time

How many battery energy storage applications have been filed in the UK? More than 100 planning applications for battery energy storage systems were filed in the UK between April and June, covering a combined 8.4GW of capacity. That is more than twice as much as in the same quarter last year. What is the biggest battery storage project in the UK? The 1,400MW (3,100MWh) project will be the largest battery storage project in the UK, and one of the largest in Europe. The project was approved by Doncaster Council on 28 January and will help strengthen the local economy by creating jobs during the construction and operation of the facility. Is the battery storage pipeline growing in the UK? Overall though, the breakdown of the battery storage pipeline in the UK indicates a position of growth, with a large proportion of the pipeline capacity in early development, in planning and consented stages. Which country commissions the most battery storage projects in the UK? Figure 2 illustrates the trend in commissioning of battery storage projects in the UK. Over the last decade, England has seen the majority of commissioning of battery storage projects (83% since). Will there be a surge in battery energy storage projects? There will be a potential surge in battery energy storage system (BESS) projects receiving grid connection offers before following regulatory reforms approved by energy regulator Ofgem, according to a new study. How many BESS projects will Firstway energy have in ? The largest of the three projects is a 200MW system at Mill Hey in Capenhurst, Cheshire, connecting to the Capenhurst substation. A final investment decision is expected in April with the first battery systems expected to be operational in early . Most of the projects are in the early stages: either announced by developers, included in the TEC register, or have screening/scoping applications submitted. Inclusion in the TEC register is an early stage in a (typically larger) project, and normally comes before a planning application.
