



Uzbekistan to build solar panel factory

Will Uzbekistan fund a 250-megawatt solar photovoltaic plant?TASHKENT, May 21, -- The World Bank Group, Abu Dhabi Future Energy Company PJSC (Masdar), and the Government of Uzbekistan have signed a financial package to fund a 250-megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic plant with a 63-MW battery energy storage system (BESS). What is the solar furnace of Uzbekistan?The Solar Furnace of Uzbekistan was built in Uzbekistan and opened in as a part of a Soviet Union "Sun" Complex Research Facility, being the world largest concentrator. In this context, the World Bank Group is helping Uzbekistan develop 2,000 MW of solar and 500 MW of wind energy by attracting private sector investments.
