"The most difficult thing is to integrate and find spaces to build photovoltaic infrastructure in places that are already heavily built up," said ACEA president, Barbara UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon called it a "moral voice," while writer Pankaj Mishra called it "arguably the most important piece of intellectual criticism in our time."
